

The **Center for Student Success** seeks undergraduate students with strong interpersonal skills and an interest in supporting peers as a Peer Subject Tutor for Fall 2020.

The CSS Peer Subject Tutor is a **paid position** that includes **customized training and ongoing reflective leadership practice**, all within an **inclusive, supportive environment**.

Peer Subject Tutors work with small groups of up to 3 students to help them develop strategies and tools to support learning in one of our offered courses. They encourage critical thinking, academic independence, and the progression of the learning process through questioning. See below for supported courses.

If hired for the position, students will be required to take a 1-credit training course during the first semester of tutoring. Satisfactory completion of the course and concurrent tutoring sessions allow peer tutors to work towards earning tutor certification through the College Reading and Learning Association (CRLA).
