## 'Newtown' documentary will be shown at SUNY New Paltz March 7

NEW PALTZ, N.Y. >> The documentary "Newtown" will be shown at 6:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 7 at SUNY New Paltz Lecture Center Room 102. The screening is free and open to the public.

Filmed over the course of three years and directed by award-winning filmmaker Kim A. Snyder, "Newtown" documents the aftermath of the Dec. 14, 2012, attack on Sandy Hook Elementary

School, and explores what happens to a community after it becomes the epicenter of a national discussion, and what is left to cope with after the cameras leave.

A panel discussion with individuals affected by the shooting, including the parent of one of the slain children, will follow. The Counseling Center will staff a quiet room during the screening and panel discussion.
