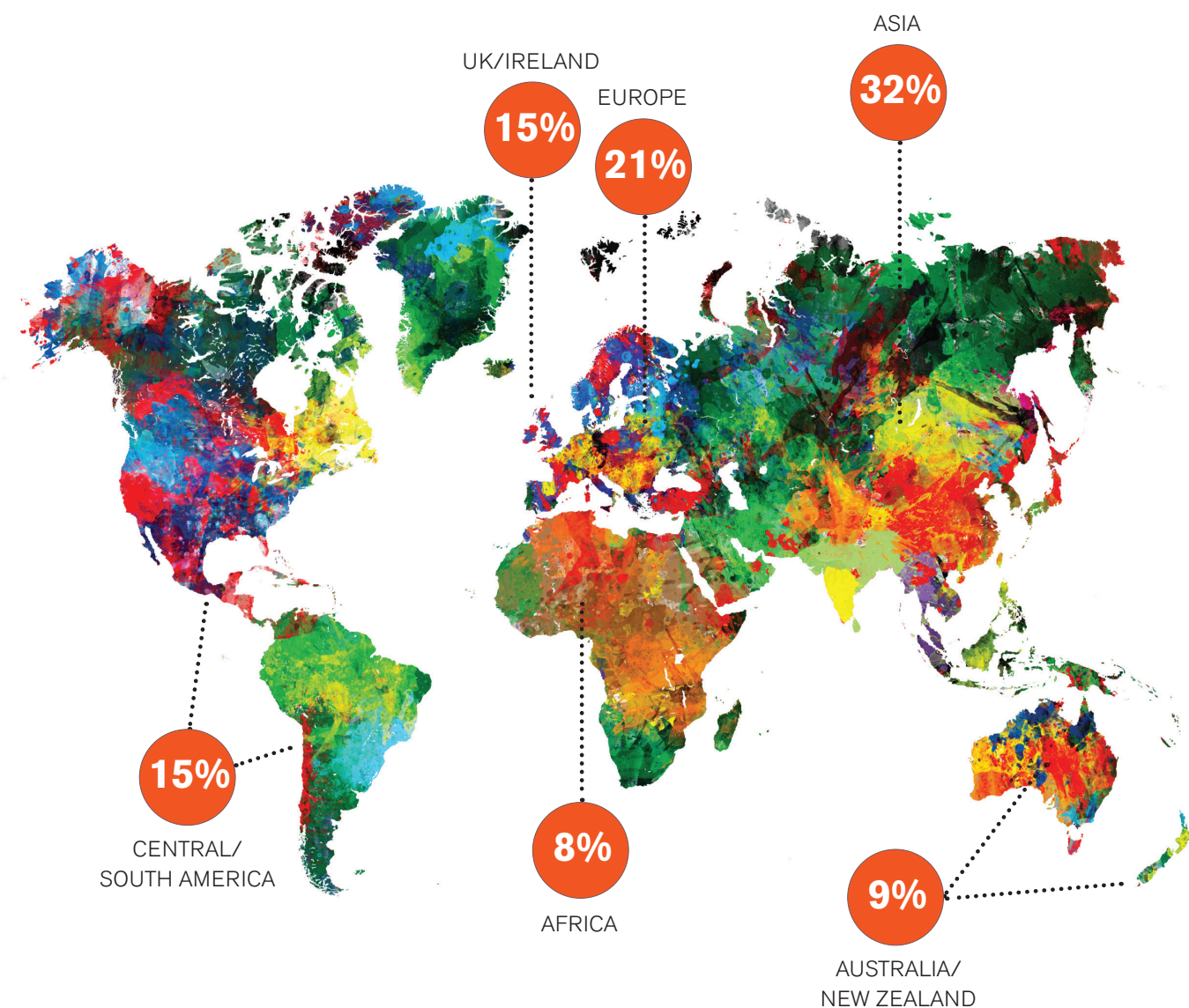

■ Admission Requirements

- Official transcripts in sealed envelopes, (high school average 85% or higher)
- Local and state board scores, if available
- TRANSFERS: Minimum GPA 2.75 (Evaluation of non-US university transcripts by NACES approved agency is recommended)
- Admission essay (personal statement)
- 1 letter of recommendation
- Official standardized exams, if available (SAT/ACT not required)
- IELTS 6.5, TOEFL iBT 80 (Conditional Admission offered)
- Copy of passport - after admission, required for I-20
- Financial documents (bank statement) - after admission, required for I-20

Application fee of \$50 required for processing

■ Application Deadlines

- December 1 for Spring semester (January start)
- June 15 for Fall semester (August start)

■ Annual Tuition and Fees

Tuition: \$16,980

Mandatory university fees and foreign student health insurance: \$3,522

Room and board: \$13,928

Total university cost: \$34,430*

Personal expenses and books: \$4,430

Total: \$38,860

* Tuition and fees for the 2019–2020 academic year are estimated and subject to change at any time.

\$38,860 USD Required to document for issuance of I-20 for student visa: reflects all school fees, as well as personal expenses, books and supplies (\$4,430).

■ No TOEFL? No IELTS? No Problem!

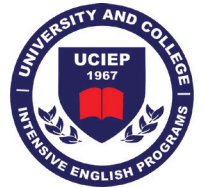
SUNY New Paltz is the only SUNY comprehensive university to offer its own year-round intensive English language program. Students may be conditionally admitted without proof of English proficiency if they meet all other admissions standards.

Upon arrival to New Paltz, students will be tested and placed into academic, Pathway or ESL courses, as needed.

Academic course credits are granted through the Pathway program to meet undergraduate degree requirements.

Summer English course options are also available for students who would like extra support before beginning their degree program.
