

■ Admission Requirements

- Official transcripts in sealed envelopes, (high school average 85% or higher)
- Local and state board scores, if available
- TRANSFERS: Minimum GPA 2.75 (Evaluation of non-US university transcripts by NACES approved agency is recommended)
- Admission essay (personal statement)
- 1 letter of recommendation
- Official standardized exams, if available (SAT/ACT not required)
- IELTS 6.5, TOEFL iBT 80 (Conditional Admission offered)
- Copy of passport after admission, required for I-20
- Financial documents (bank statement) after admission, required for I-20

Application fee of \$50 required for processing

■ Application Deadlines

- December 1 for Spring semester (January start)
- June 15 for Fall semester (August start)

■ Annual Tuition and Fees

Tuition: \$16,980

Room and board: \$13,928

Total university cost: \$34,430*

Personal expenses and books: \$4,430

Total: \$38,860

Mandatory university fees and foreign student health insurance: \$3,522

\$38,860 USD Required to document for issuance of *I-20 for student visa: reflects all school fees, as well as* personal expenses, books and supplies (\$4,430).


