Exemplar is a young Black woman pursuing a higher education in an environment where individuals demographically reflected and shared similar experiences. Hence, her transfer to NP and participation in SMP, a program that motivates her to pursue academic excellence while giving back to her community. Since joining the organization, she's maintained a high GPA earning Dean's every semester. She also assisted with recruiting potential incoming students to the program by participating in general interest phone calls, Open House, panels, and campus tours. Additionally, Exemplar finds ways to service her community through education. As a Digital Media Production major Exemplar is expected to creatively express herself in her work and believes her best work is created when it focuses on her passion for her community. In Field Production, she produced a documentary, "Breaking Barriers" which focuses on the history and perseverance of SMP. The following semester she took BLK 420, a course where she mentored two fellow SMP students. By providing academic and professional guidance she established a solid relationship with them on behalf of the program. Exemplar's commitment to SMP has led her to be a two-time winning recipient of The Margaret Wade Lewis Memorial Endowment Scholarship. Additionally, Exemplar was asked to be the Scholarship Reception Speaker in

April 2024 and later asked to write and sign for the FFNP Appeal on behalf of the Office of Development and Alumni Relations. Overall, Exemplar's diligence in SMP led to an extension of involvement on campus.

Exemplar has taken part in research in both applied mathematics and experimental physics. During the summer and fall of 2024, Exemplar worked with faculty studying the connectivity and synchronization of complex quadratic nodes. This work utilized graph theory and linear algebraic concepts to examine the Mandelbrot contours of such nodes. In May of 2024, Exemplar traveled to the Biology and Applied Mathematics in Medicine conference in Richmond, Virginia to present this work in her talk "Universality and synchronization in complex quadratic nodes." Starting in the spring of 2023, Exemplar has been working with faculty examining the birefringent properties of calcite crystals using methods of polarimetry and optical tweezers. In October of 2023, Exemplar presented this work in a poster at the Frontiers in Optics + Laser Science conference in Rochester, NY. Since beginning at SUNY New Paltz, Exemplar has been a part of the Honors program, and is currently writing her honors thesis about her optical physics research. Also through the honors program, she had the opportunity to tutor astronomy to a fellow honors student. This experience inspired Exemplar to work as an astrophysics teaching assistant at a summer program for gifted students in the summer of 2024.
